PUBLIC WORKS LABORER

The Town of Garland is currently seeking a public works laborer. The public works laborer is responsible for the operation of a variety of construction and maintenance equipment and for performing manual labor activities as needed and or required by the public works department. Included is road maintenance, park maintenance, signage, water and sewer repairs, and other related duties.

The position requires operation of town owned vehicles, such as pick-up trucks, backhoe, dump trucks, motor grader, mowers, as required for town maintenance. The operation of power tools and equipment such as mowers, chain saws, air compressors, etc is required and necessary. The candidate will be required to inspect, repair, maintain, and inventory equipment as required by department procedures as well as to be able to make repairs to town roads, curbs, and sidewalks as needed.

The applicant will mow grass, plant, and/or prune trees, flowers, and hedges. There is a requirement to maintain all town-owned buildings, clean the public works garage, park facilities, as well as clean up litter and empty trash cans. Maintenance of sanitary and storm sewers and/or conducting routine maintenance procedures is required. Sweeping and clean up of debris and materials from roads will be required as well as snow and ice removal, including manual shoveling of snow. Maintenance and upkeep of all town- owned vehicles, equipment, and inventory of all supplies and equipment within the public works department is required.

A valid North Carolina driver's license is required. The candidate will be required to perform heavy manual labor, including lifting heavy objects and working in all types of weather conditions. Safety procedures and practices are required to be followed, as well as wearing safety equipment. A good working relationship with co-workers, board members, and the general public is a necessity. The candidate may be called out for emergencies such as sewer back-ups, water emergencies, street repairs, and must be knowledgeable in a variety of semi-skilled and skilled maintenance tasks.

Seeking a candidate who has good work ethic and initiative. A background check and drug testing is required.
